### HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION

#### A. SHORT TERM (ACUTE) EXPOSURE

SWALLOWED	Alkaline corrosive to mouth and throat. May cause burning sensation and abdominal discomfort.
EYES	Irritating and corrosive to eyes. May cause chemical conjunctivitis and redness and watering of eyes with damage to cornea.
SKIN	It will dry the skin and may cause alkali burns and irritant (contact) dermatitis.
INHALED	Irritating to nose, throat and respiratory system causing coughing and sneezing.

#### B. LONG TERM (CHRONIC) EXPOSURE

INHALED	Repeated inhalation of dust containing crystalline silica can cause bronchitis, silicosis (scarring of the lung) and lung cancer.
SKIN	Repeated skin contact has been associated with both irritant dermatitis and allergic (contact) dermatitis.
